Marcita Bareboat Week 25-31st May


After the Semaine du Golfe festival in the Gulf of Morbihan Marcita is available for a week's bareboat charter.

We're planning to leave her in Crouesty, a huge marina which is not in the Morbihan but outside on Quiberon Bay. From there it is an easy 28 miles to Arzon, with a possible stop at Pénerf. At Arzal you lock into the Vilaine river, which gives easy and delightful river sailing up as far as Redon. past the wonderful old port of La Roche Bernard. The river is peaceful and beautiful, with a few traditional net fishermen and no development, rather like the Orwell with sun. The wind goes either up or down the river, so you're either coasting along under Genoa or motoring, if you don't fancy tacking every minute or two.


Alternatively, you could sail around the Gulf of Morbihan, stopping at lovely moorings and anchorages in the lee of the many islands, and dinghying ashore for meals or picnics. Vannes is a famous medieval city, about 3 hours sail from Crouesty, and there will still be many of the 800 or so classic wooden boats that attended the festival the week before. Mooring will be free that week for boats that have attended the festival.

Charts and tidal atlases will be on board, and if you've ever fancied sailing in South Brittany you couldn't have a better opportunity than this.
